Reconfirmation Meeting for March 15, 2021 through April 16, 2021. The week of March 29, 2021 MPPS was not in session for spring break.

Reviewed at MPPS Board of Education held in the MPHS Performing Arts Center on Monday, April 19, 2021:

Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

Elementary Level (K-5th grade)

- Students will still have the option to attend face to face or virtual (Oilers Online). If your child is a current OO student, we do need you to complete a new enrollment form for 3rd trimester.
- Teachers will no longer have blended rosters. This means some students will have to change teachers in order to shift class rosters.
- COVID protocols remain in place, including required masks, regular deep cleaning and disinfecting, whenever possible desks will be spaced 6 feet apart, social distancing, families will screen students for any health concerns before the leave for school.

Middle School (6th – 8th Grade)

- Mt Pleasant Middle School will maintain the cohort model through the end of the school year. Students also have the option of choosing the Oilers Online (virtual) program.
- For our face to face students, the school day ends at approximately 11:57. Students are sent home with a lunch that is free for all students.
- Every Wednesday (beginning the week of November 16th) will be a day of virtual learning for all MPMS students.
- COVID protocols remain in place, including required masks, regular deep cleaning and disinfecting, whenever possible desks will be spaced 6 feet apart, social distancing, families will screen students for any health concerns before the leave for school.

High School & GI-TEC (9th – 12th Grade)

- For the 3rd trimester, all MPHS students will have the option to attend face to face 4 days per week.
- For all MPHS and GI-TEC students every Wednesday will be a day of virtual learning.
- COVID protocols remain in place, including required masks, regular deep cleaning and disinfecting, whenever possible desks will be spaced 6 feet apart, social distancing, families will screen students for any health concerns before the leave for school.
