Guidelines for Volunteers

A volunteer is a person from the community who has been approved by the Mt. Pleasant School District for the purpose of providing assistance on a consistent basis without pay.

- Volunteers shall work under the supervision of the designated assistant, principal or director.
- Volunteers must abide by all school and state regulations.
- Volunteers should always refer parental concerns to the principal.
- Only authorized and approved volunteers will be covered by school district liability insurance; volunteers will not be covered by workers compensation.
- Volunteers may only treat student injuries in the case of an emergency. All other injuries shall be referred to the appropriate administrator.
- Volunteers are responsible for their actions. Inappropriate conduct as determined by the principal will result in the discontinuation of the volunteer's relationship with the program.
- Volunteers will be subject to criminal background checks upon request of the school administration. Volunteers convicted of a felony will not be allowed to provide assistance or instruction for Mt. Pleasant Public Schools.
