For the week of September 13, 2021: Isabella County is in **High Transmission**

| <b>Level of Community Transmission</b> | <b>MPPS Mask Protocol</b>   | <b>Number of cases per building</b>   |

| High Transmission                      | All students and staff will be required to wear masks at all times inside.            | All students and staff will be required to wear masks at all times inside.  |
| Substantial Transmission               | All students up to age 12 will wear masks at all times inside                         | If the number of cases in a building represents more than 1% of the total student and staff population, all students and staff in that building will mask until that percentage drops below 0.5%. |
| Moderate Transmission                  | All students up to age 12 will wear masks inside, except when seated in the classroom | If the number of cases in a building represents more than 1% of the total student and staff population, all students and staff in that building will mask until that percentage drops below 0.5%. |
| Low Transmission                       | Masks are optional for all  | Masks are optional for all unless there is an outbreak in a building.   |
