

MPPS Mask Protocol

For the week of November 1, 2021: Isabella County is in **High Transmission**

Level of Community Transmission	MPPS Mask Protocol	Number of cases per building
High Transmission	All students and staff will be required to wear masks at all times inside.	All students and staff will be required to wear masks at all times inside.
Substantial Transmission	All students up to age 12 will wear masks at all times inside	If the number of cases in a building represents more than 1% of the total student and staff population, all students and staff in that building will mask until that percentage drops below 0.5%.
Moderate Transmission	All students up to age 12 will wear masks inside, except when seated in the classroom	If the number of cases in a building represents more than 1% of the total student and staff population, all students and staff in that building will mask until that percentage drops below 0.5%.
Low Transmission	Masks are optional for all	Masks are optional for all unless there is an outbreak in a building.
