Grade Span	Learning Options
<b>DK-5th Grade Students</b>	In person, face-to-face learning is the only option that Mt. Pleasant Public Schools are offering to DK-5 students at this time.
<b>6-8th Grade (MPMS) Students</b>	<b>WAY (Widening Advancements for Youth) Forward Middle School Program</b> - hybrid model of online and in person learning for middle and high school students.
<b>9-12 Grade (MPHS) Students</b>	<p><b>WAY (Widening Advancements for Youth) High School Program</b> - hybrid model of online and in person learning for middle and high school students.</p> <p><b>MPHS individualizes schedules (Odysseyware)</b> - classes in a virtual format, partial day attendance, and reduced schedules are options.</p>
